





Preparation:

The drill is used to drill holes into different materials. Portable power hand drills are made in various sizes and vary in power from light to heavy and in speeds from slow to fast. The drill can help to prepare a hole so that you can drill a screw into the wood. The hole should be straight and smaller than the screw. Without proper preparation, a screw could get off track and go in crooked. The power hand drill can use a variety of bits that can be changed according to what function you want it to perform.

In this activity, you will learn to:

- Use power hand tools to practice drilling holes into wood
- Use power hand tools to practice driving screws into wood.

Procedures:

1. Review all three Safety Handouts before beginning.
* SAFETY NOTE: Everyone should exercise extreme caution when using power tools.

2. Get the drill. Be sure the switch trigger is in the OFF position when not in use.






