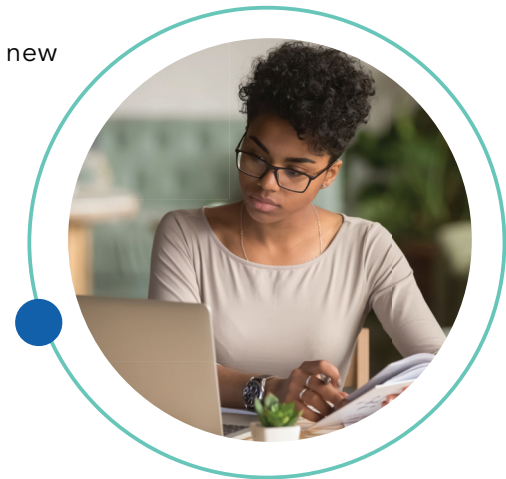


🕒 How do you support student engagement and motivation?
